

Article 6 Issuing Registry

Maintain Control of ITMO authorizations and trading within a registry administered by multilateral group



Lifecycle Control and Security

The Host Country Will Maintain Full Control of Registry Throughout Lifecycle

Lifecycle Control

- At no point will changes be made to a registry without express written authorization from the Host Country.
- Xpansiv's SaaS hosting model will allow the Host Country to immediately benefit from our current framework, including rapid availability and minimized investment costs.
- However, the Host Country must propose, approve, or opt into any changes in SaaS functionality Xpansiv is deploying on their behalf.
- Our SOC2 certification requires client permission to commit a functional change to production.

Security

- Xpansiv has been SOC2 certified since 2018 and was last audited in 2024 with zero findings.
- Xpansiv complies with all requirements under the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
- Our role-based security model enforces appropriate system access for users depending on their function, including Xpansiv staff responsible for maintaining the registry.
- Key security features like multi-factor authentication will be available "out-of-the-box."
- Authorized Xpansiv personnel responsible for infrastructure administration have limited, job specific access to servers and databases..
- All communications between users' web browsers and the system will use the secure SSL/HTTPS protocol.



Potential Commercial Arrangements

Xpansiv is Open to a Variety of Commercial Structures

Multiple Potential Fee Structures:

One-Time Development

Represents the initial development and configuration work necessary to stand up the registry.

Annual Licensing

Reflects ongoing maintenance needs and contingent upon the various ongoing services utilized (i.e., program administration, KYC, Billing Service, Cash Management Service).

Can be structured to include additional development hours at a reduced rate.

Volumetric

Can be used to defray development or licensing fees.

Aligns total costs with market activity.
