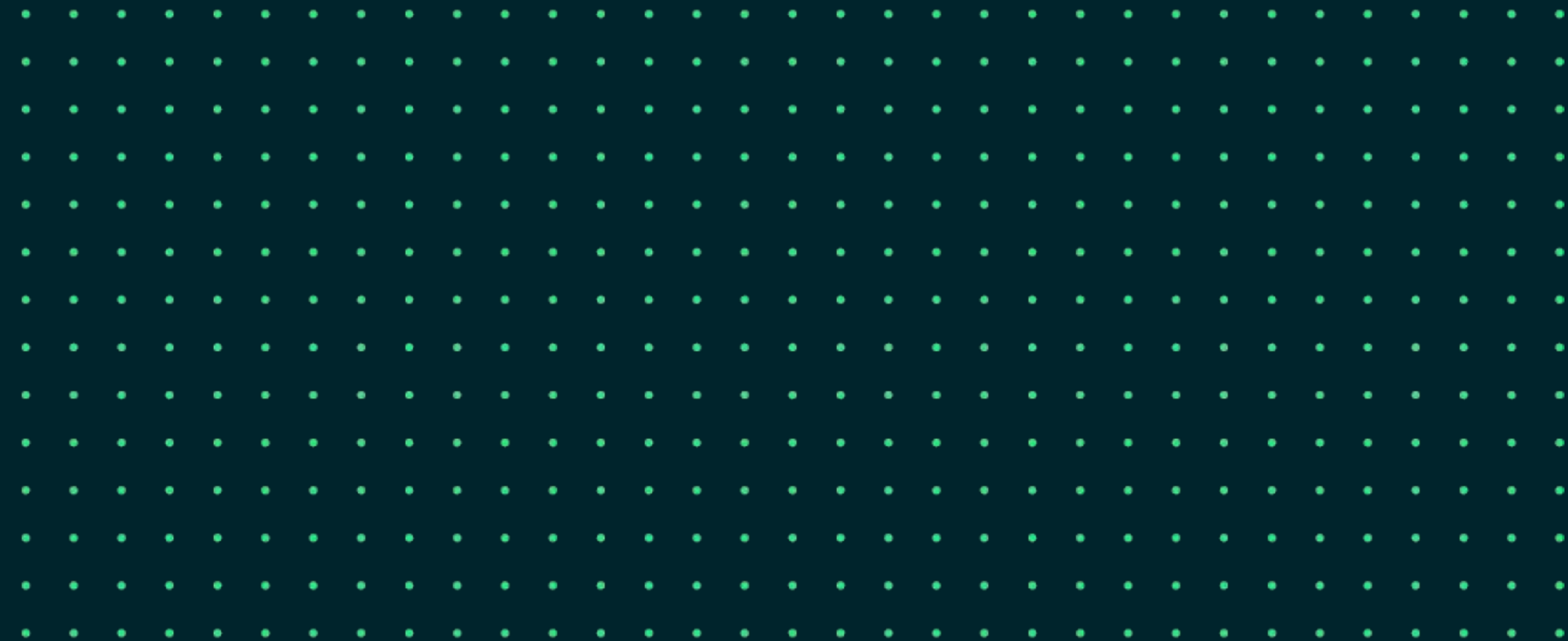

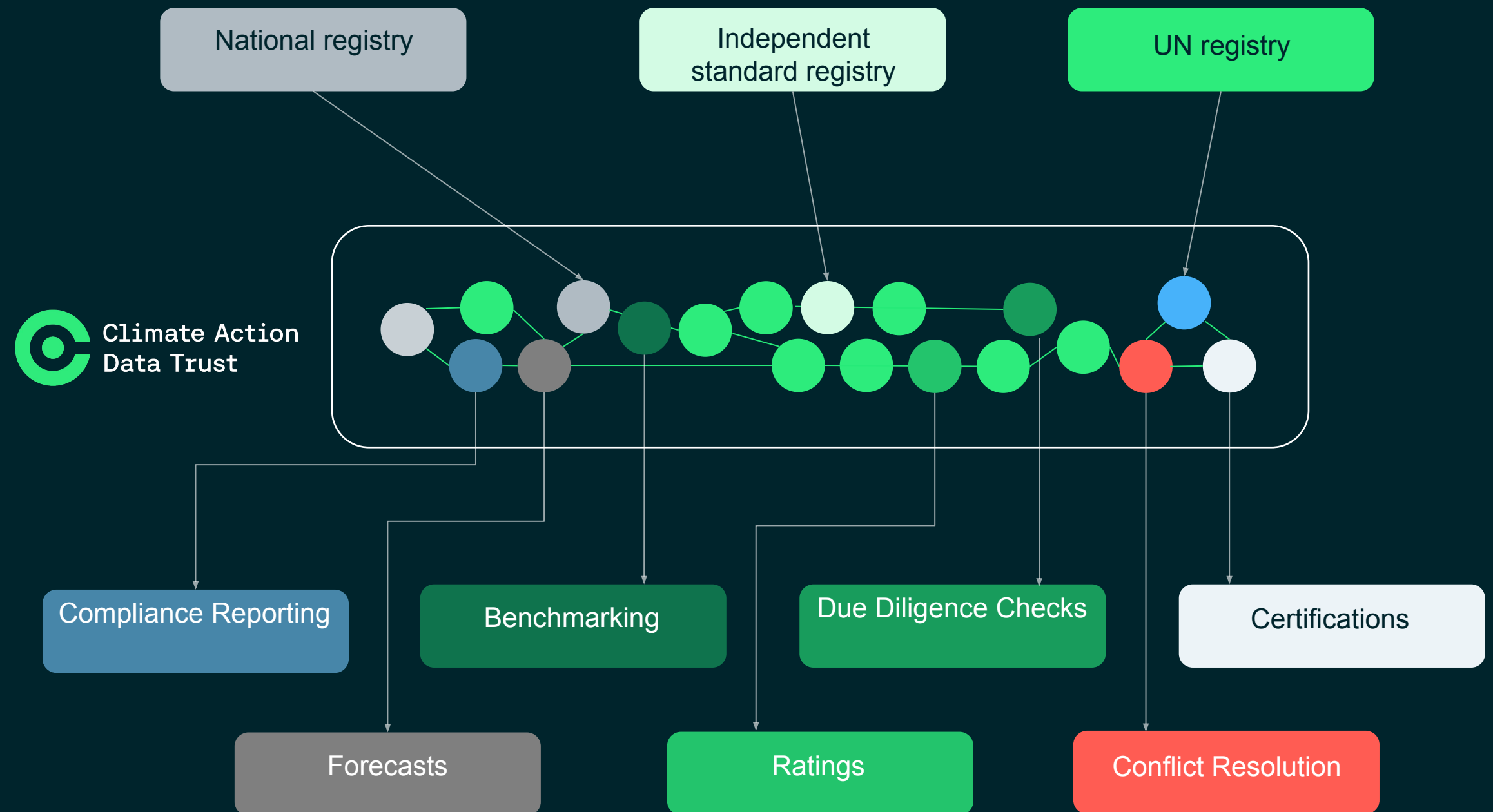

CAD Trust links, aggregates and harmonizes carbon credit data



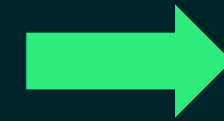
- Public, decentralized and trackable record of carbon credit information

# Value proposition for governments



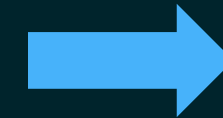
- Data reconciliation between national and independent registries

- Visibility of investment opportunities

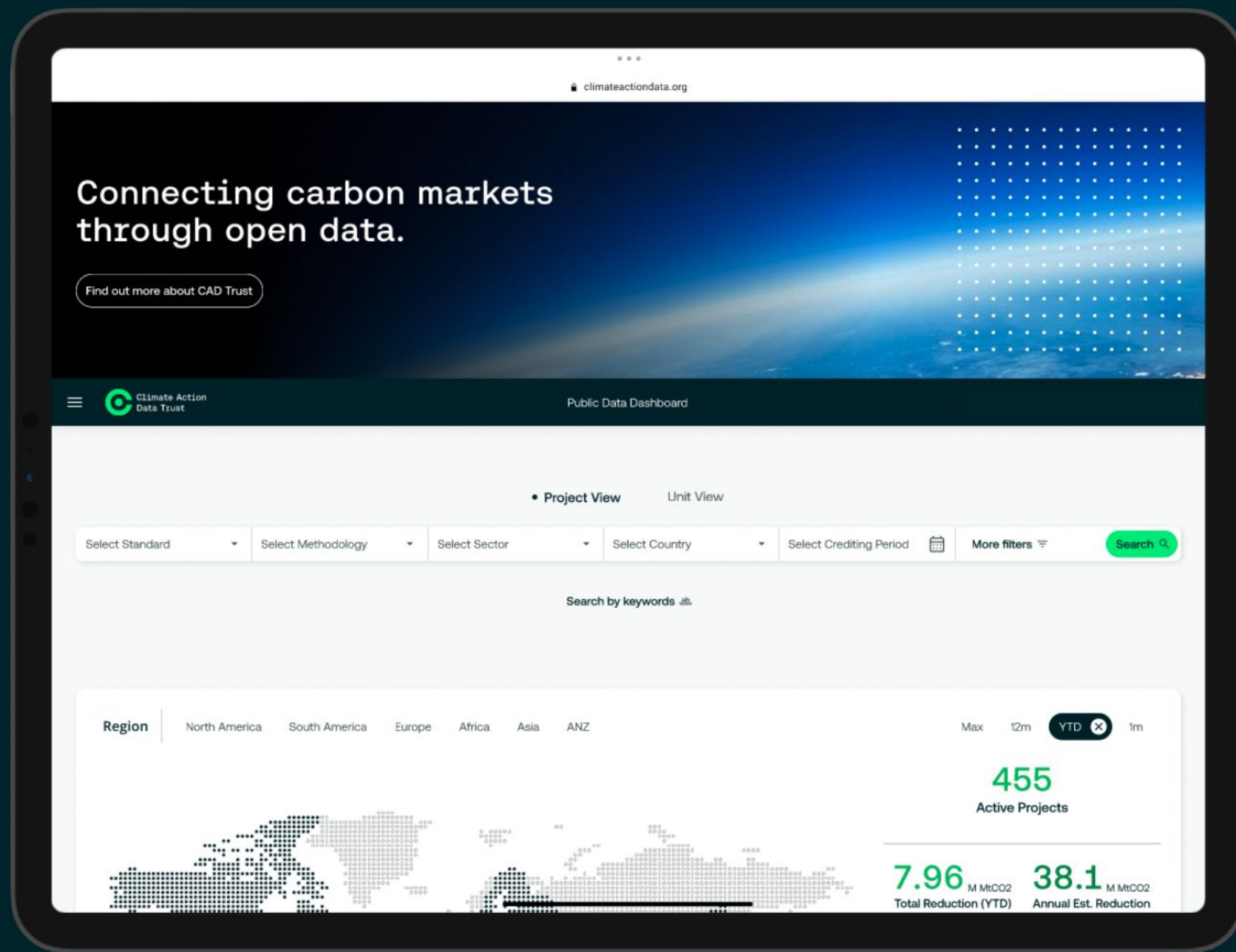


- Help raise finance from private and public sector buyers

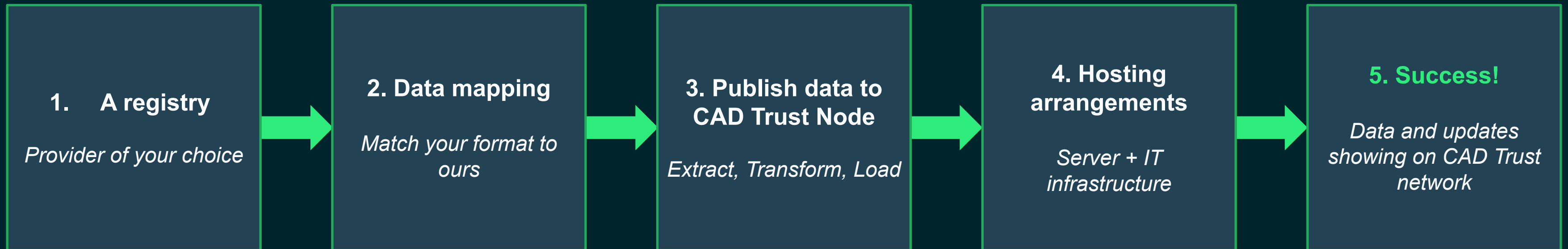

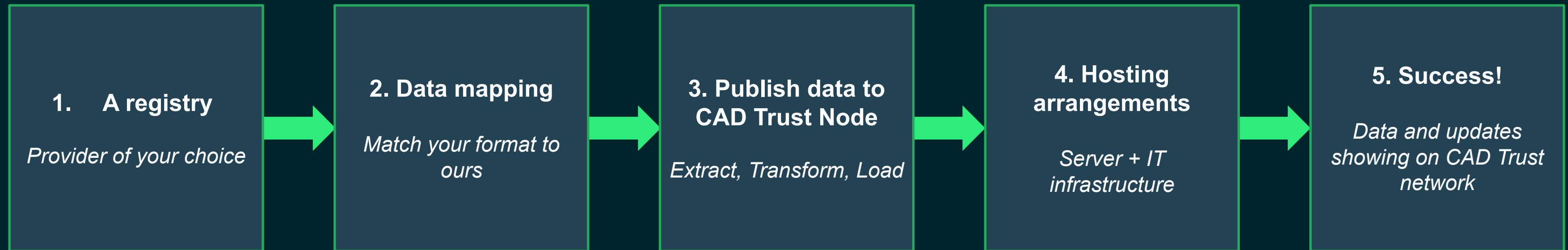
