PROGRESS ON CLIMATE CHANGE POLICY OF TURKEY

- 21 September 2021 76th UN General Assembly President R.T. Erdoğan stated that Paris Agreement will be submitted to endorsement of Parliament
- 27 September 2021 Cabinet Meeting 2053 Net Zero Target and Green Development Initiative is declared by President Erdoğan
- 06 October 2021 Turkish Parliament Paris Agreement was ratified by consensus
- 10 November 2021 Turkey officially became a party to PA

A depositary notification that Turkey would implement the agreement as a developing country without prejudice to its economic and social development rights.







ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT

PRESIDENCY OF CLIMATE CHANGE

- Established on 29/10/2021 by Presidential Decree No.85
- Affiliated institution to the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change

DUTY AND RESPONSIBILITY

- In context of climate change and thinning of ozone layer
 - \checkmark To determine strategies at national and international level
 - ✓ Carrying out the negotiation processes
 - ✓ Monitoring of GHGs and establishment of market-based mechanisms
 - ✓ Provide national coordination, legislation, reporting, awareness activities
- By-law on Instutitonal Structure, Procudures and Principals published in June 2022

Renewable Energy replaces job losses caused by phasing out fossil fuels?


- 300.000 new jobs

Application of the Green Jobs Assessment Model for Türkiye







Population development, Türkiye, 2019-2030


